### “Wise Words from David”

*My son, give me your heart, and let your eyes observe my ways (Proverbs 23:26).*

Men, ~~sometimes~~ it's easier to show our boys how to throw or catch a football than it is to appropriate spirituality into our lives. Fair enough. Let's compare giving our hearts to God to catching a football. 1) To catch a football you need to see it coming. In other words, you must anticipate it coming (this is mental). 2) Then you need to begin the process of the catch (coordination). You must reach out for it and prepare your body to connect with the ball. You must embrace it. 3) A final, critical step that often goes awry in a game of football is you need to make sure you don't let it go. If you don't, it is called a fumble. To make a successful completion (and ultimately to gain yards) you must guard the ball with your body.

What does it mean to give God your heart? How do we do that?

1) Anticipate the word of God, 2) embrace the word of God, and 3) guard the word of God. Practically, this means that we need to have a tender heart, ready to obey the truth we hear, whether it comes from our parents, our teachers, our employer, our government, or our church leadership. Is it feelings driven? No. It means that we need to be growing in our knowledge of the character of God in the Word of God, so that when we hear truth or see truth coming, we will be ready to catch it like a football, then guard it by committing it to memory.
