“For I Am the LORD, I Do Not Change”
Malachi 3:6

If you were to sum up the year 2020 in one word, what would that be? Crazy, insane, uncertain, confusing, troublesome, different, painful, problematic...? There are numerous words to express the chaos and problems that occurred. The one word that stood out for me is “change.”

So much has changed. We no longer shake hands or gather together in large groups; we wear masks, and some try to avoid many friends as well as strangers. Many people work from home, and so many have lost their jobs and sources of income. Churches struggle to keep attendance, and many no longer meet together because of fear, amplified by the mainstream media’s coverage of the pandemic.

Yet, through it all, and with the unknown of the next moment, we can still find hope. We find peace and comfort and strength and joy in the unchanging nature of God. He reminds us in Malachi 3:6: “For I am the LORD, I do not change.” How exciting to know that He never changes, and He never leaves nor forsakes His own (Deuteronomy 31:6; Hebrews 13:5). It is with that unchanging God, who never leaves nor forsakes, that “we live and move and have our being...‘For we are also His offspring’” (Acts 17:28).
