**Dave & Lynn Champlin - Suriname, South America**



For over 40 years the Champlins have been career missionaries in Suriname, a former Dutch commonwealth in northeast South America. For many years Dave and Lynn labored on a mission outpost on the Cottica River. In 2006 their mission asked them to move their ministry to the capital city, Paramaribo. There they are working to establish stronger ties with the government agencies and assist in several of the mission's churches and outreach ministries in the capital.

**IFCA DEVOTIONAL**

**"He Meant It for Good"**

In March of last year, churches in our state were ordered to close because of the Covid pandemic. What to do? The Lord led us to adopt a three-part strategy.

First, we replaced our in-person Sunday School with a video online class. Our tiny group suddenly extended from coast to coast! We had students from the East coast and West coast as well as our own members. Not only this, but the class was larger than it had ever been. Praise the Lord!

Next, we put our Bible messages online as well. We were pleasantly surprised to learn that our messages were being heard in many states and many other countries. Again, we had many more people listening to us online than we ever had in our live services. Praise the Lord!

Finally, I took a page from the Apostle Paul's playbook. When a Roman imprisonment sidelined him from his travelling and preaching ministry, Paul was undaunted. He simply changed his mode of communication. He began to write. As a result, we have the four priceless Prison Epistles: Ephesians, Philippians, Colossians, and Philemon. Following Paul's example, I sent out a weekly "Prison Epistle" with a devotional message and news about the church.

The Bible says, "...we know that God causes all things to work together for good to those who love God, to those who are called according to His purpose" (Romans 8:28). There was nothing good about the Covid virus or its many adverse effects. Yet God used this negative event for good. Our ministry footprint was greatly expanded, new people heard the Gospel, and God gets the glory.

When bad things happen, don't lose heart. Remember that God can use them for good.
