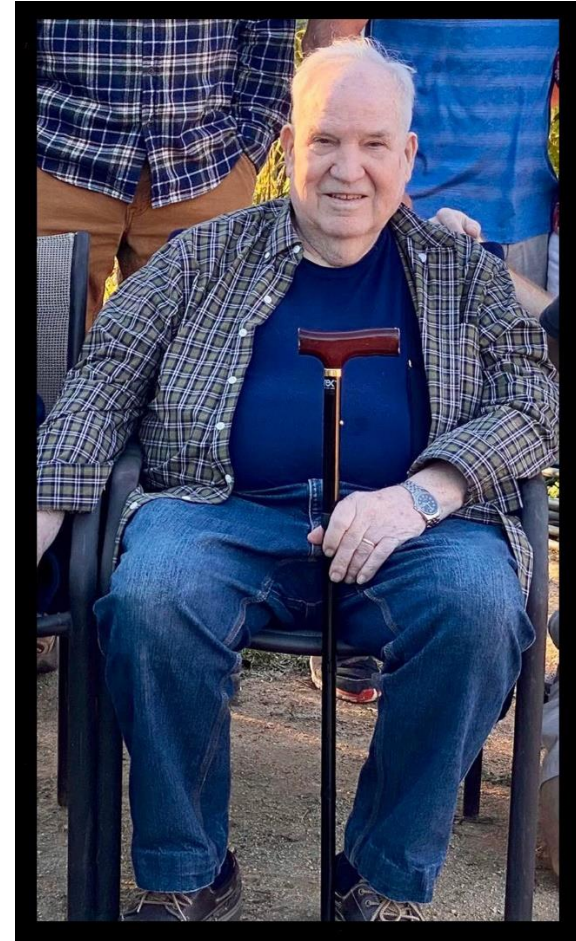
There will be a graveside service on April 25, 2022 at 10:00am at Rose Hills Memorial Park, 3888 Workman Mill Road, Whittier, CA.
